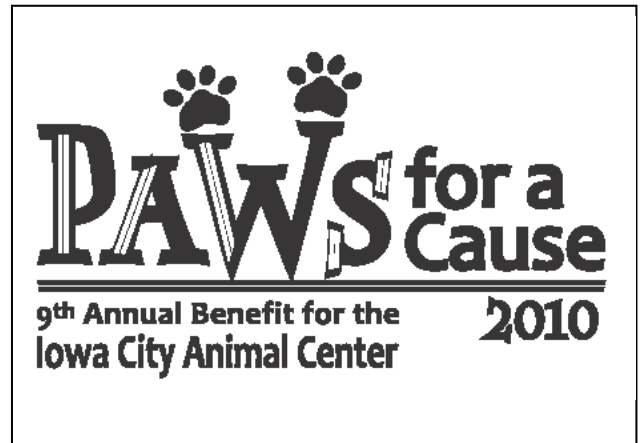

## Test your Dogs IQ...



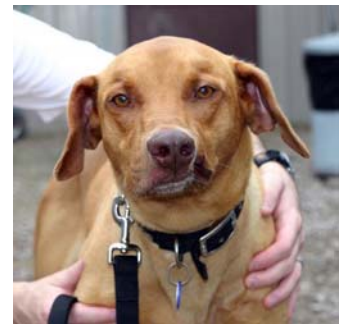

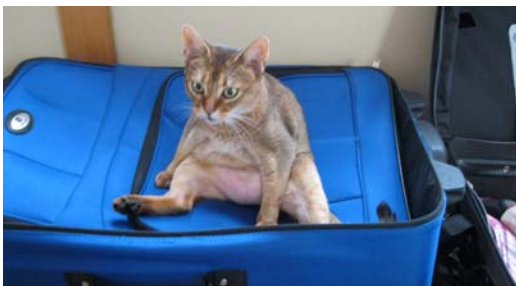
